Building on family experience that began in the 1930s with Alfonso Simeon, the company rapidly evolved.

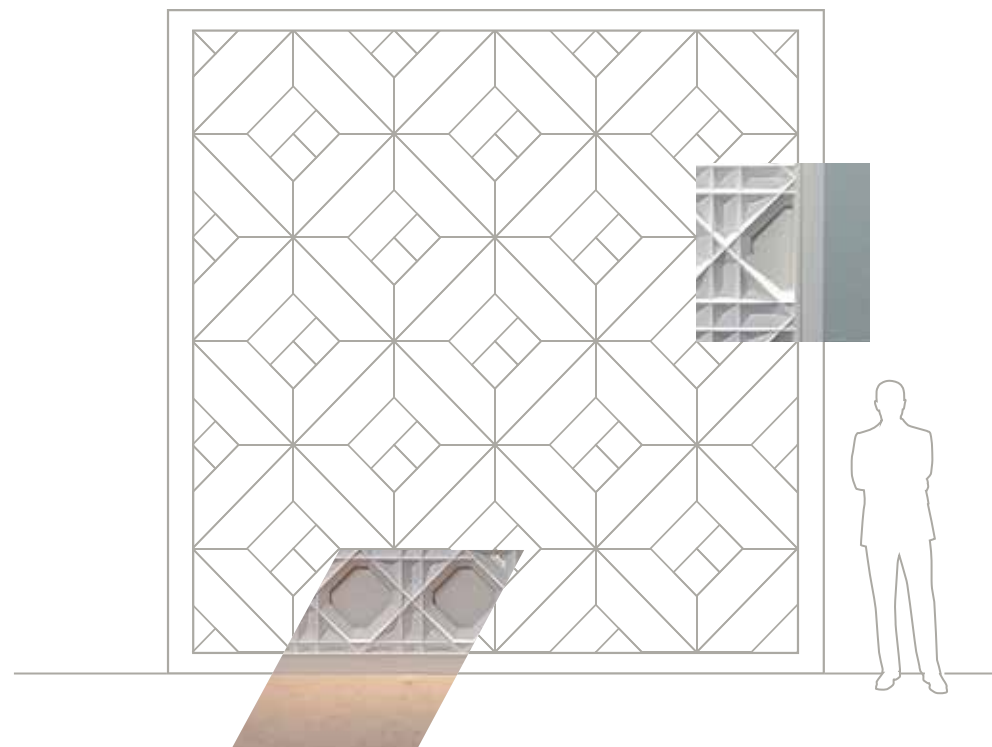
In the 1960s, under Franco Simeon, it became a key player in the production of industrial iron pre-fabrications.

Today, Simeon Group is a leading company in glass façades and metal structures for major architectural projects, with 200 employees and multiple offices in Italy, France, Monaco and United States.



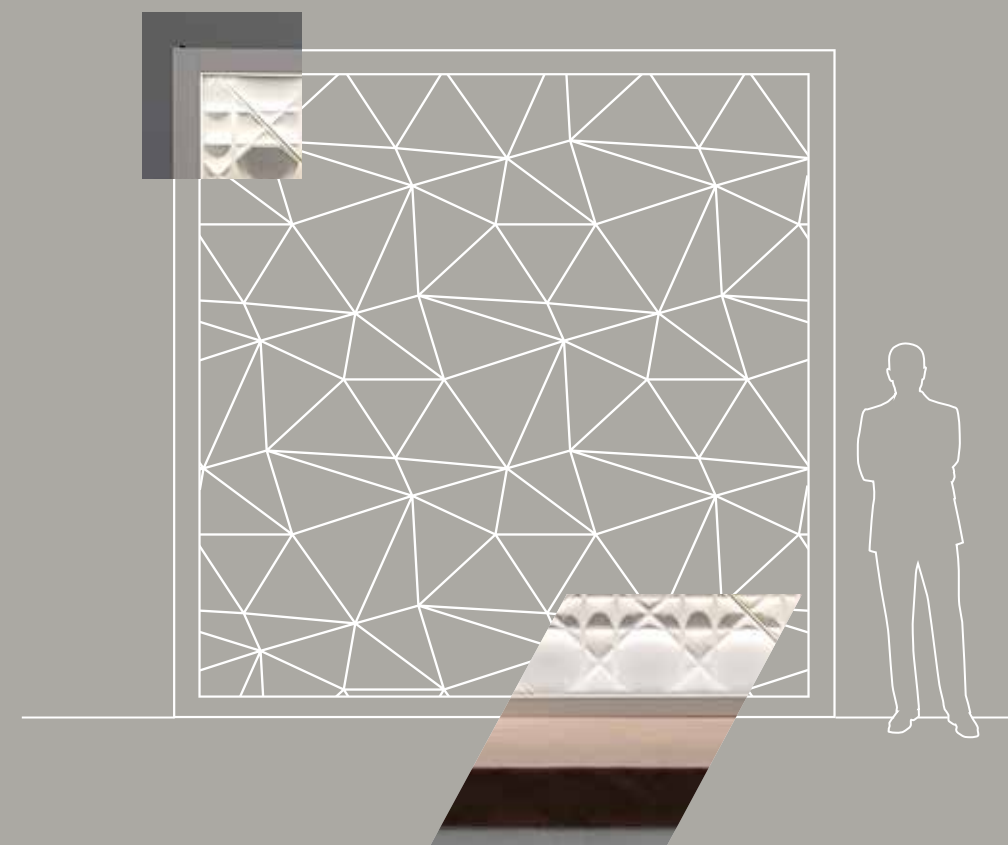

- Dimable LED light system.

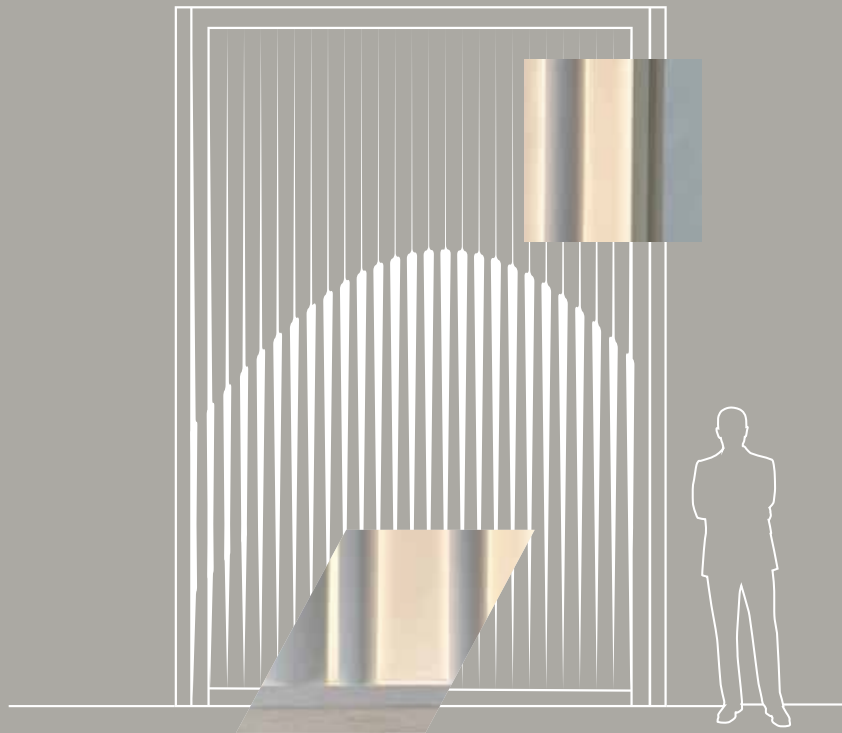

- Dimable LED light system.

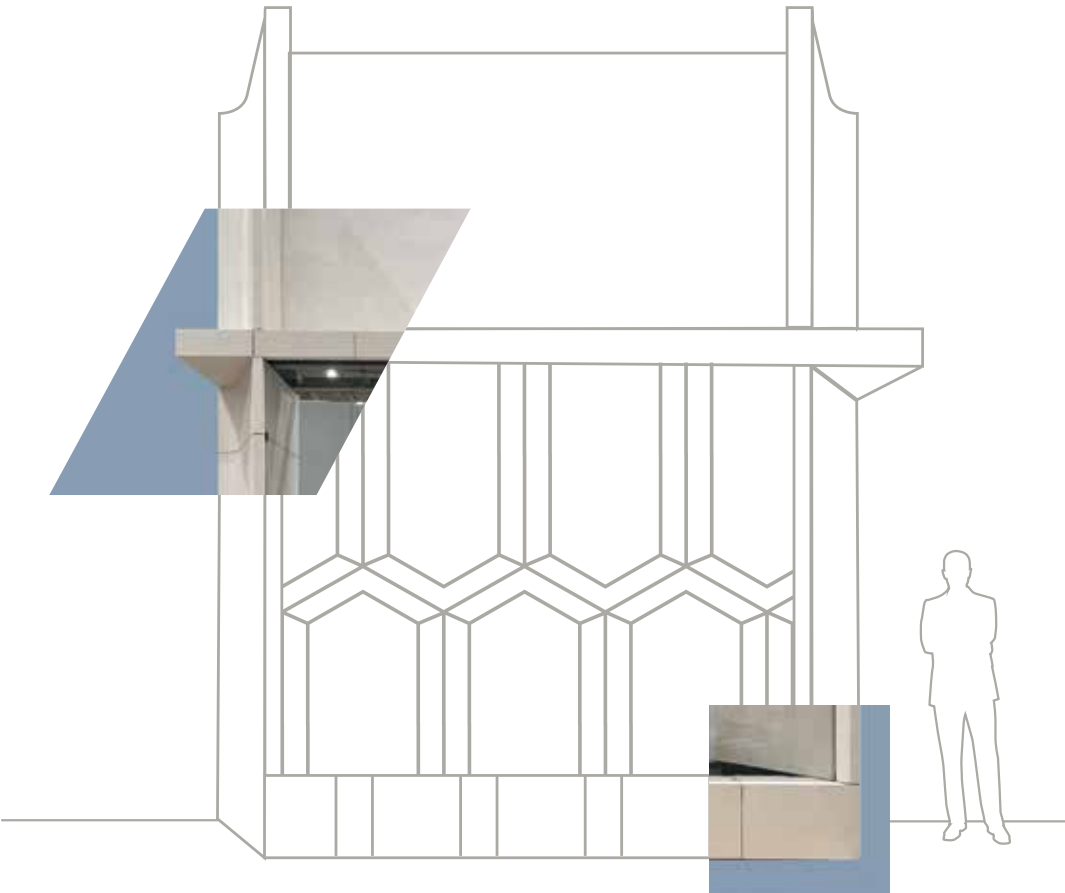

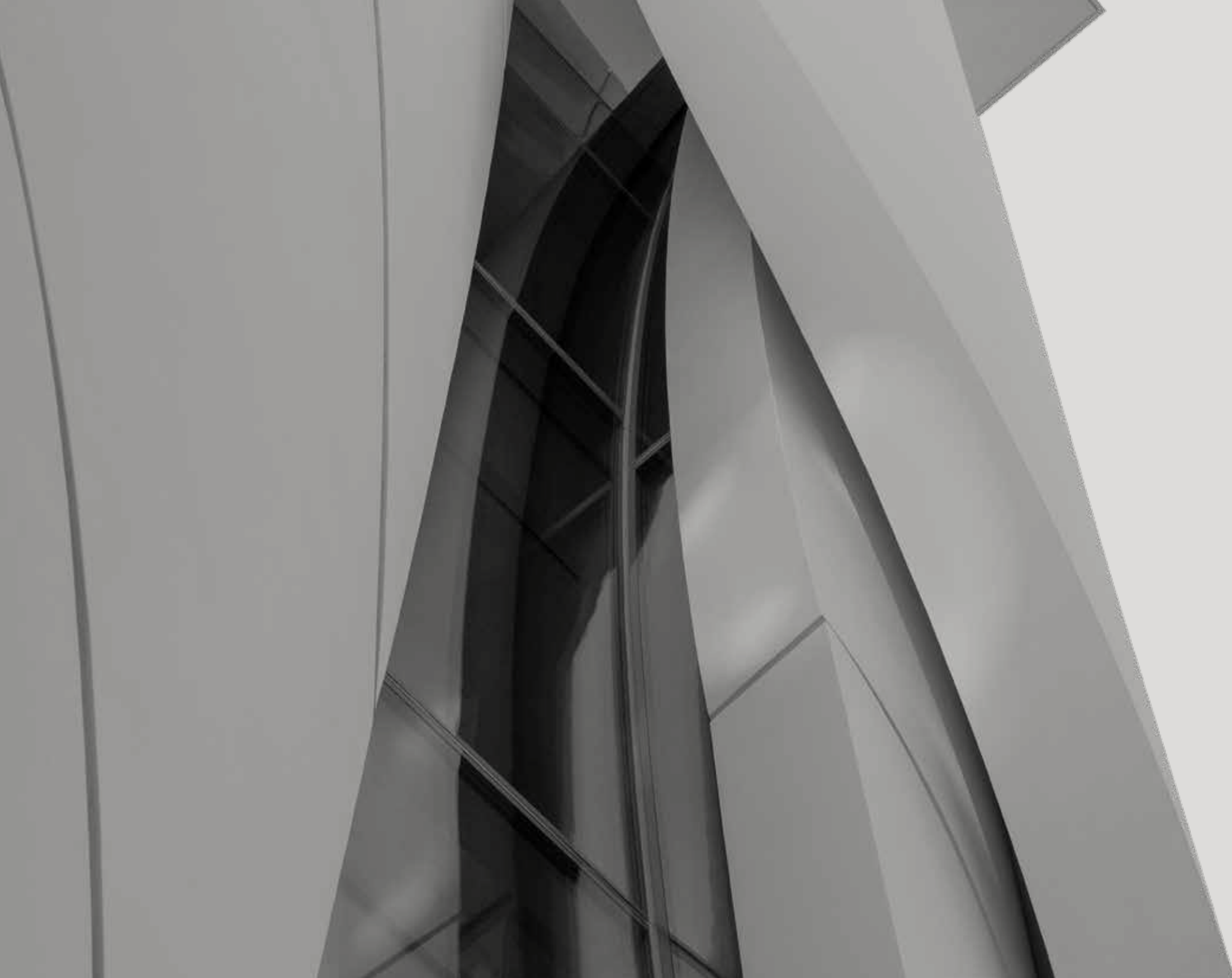

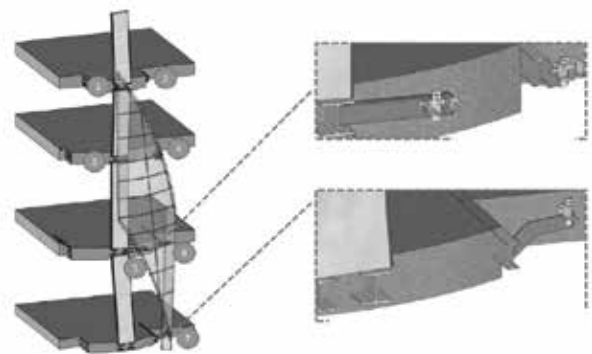

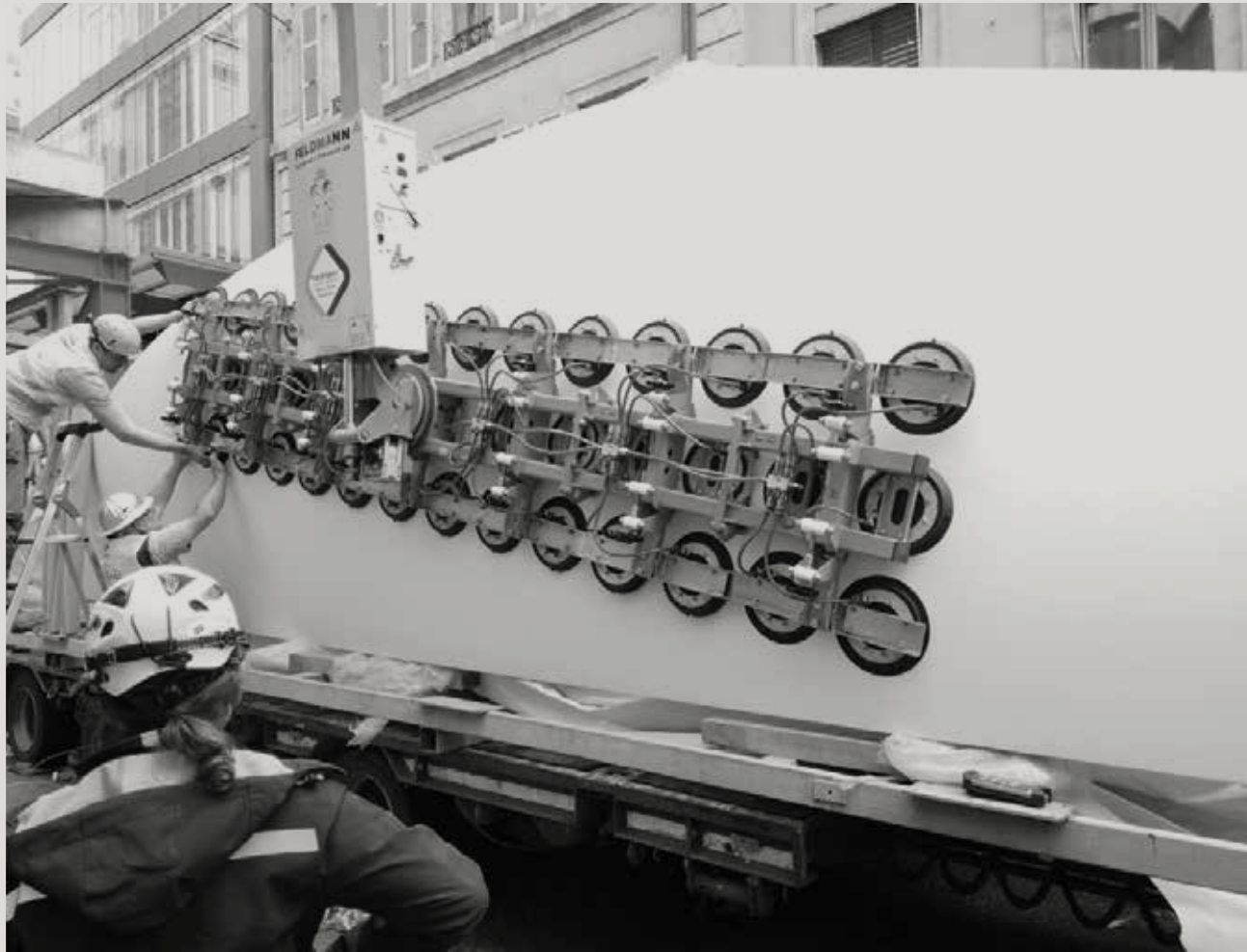
